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

# **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**

4TH LINE HAS ALWAYS BEEN ABOUT GIVING PEOPLE OPPORTUNITIES to expand their artistic practice, to step outside their comfort zone and to try something new. Ever since the theatre began in 1992, we have had this supportive training ethos at the heart of much of our work. So it was a no-brainer when our General Manager Lindy Finlan approached me, in 2018, about wanting to submit an idea for our next Christmas play. I immediately told her yes! Lindy added in a dash of mystery, some romance, a Nancy Drew-esque heroine and an impending Christmas concert to make for a fun, funny and thoughtful piece of theatre. I am so grateful to her and the over 40 artists involved in getting the play up and on its feet. I am excited to share it with you. Bundle up and enjoy!!!


Erin has been living, creating, and recreationally protesting




